Tips for Using This Article to Spread the Word of God

You have taken a very important step in downloading this article. After you have read it for yourself, I hope you will want to share it with others. Here are some suggestions you may want to use to spread God's Word by publishing this article:

Submit to a Church Newsletter

Church's are always looking for articles to run in their newsletters. Call the church first and ask them what format they prefer the article to be in. If they want the article on computer disk, you will need to go to our website, go to the page where the article appears, highlight the article and copy and paste it into either MS Word, Wordperfect, Notepad, or whatever word processing software program you use.

Depending on the software you paste the text of the article into, you may have to reformat it. (Sometimes, extra spaces and weird symbols will appear in some software programs. Therefore, I highly recommend you paste the text you copied from our website to Notepad [under Start/Programs/Accessories if you use Windows] so it will be free from formatting. Then, copy and paste the text from Notepad into your word processing program) and save on a diskette or email.

Of course, if the church accepts PDF format, you can simply email them the PDF file you downloaded originally from our website or copy onto a diskette.

Or, if the church prefers the article to be submitted in typed form, just print out a copy of the article on your printer and hand it to them. (Note: faxing the article may cause some parts of it to be hard to read.)

Offer as a Free Download From Your Website

Place this article (in PDF format) on your own website and allow others to download it free of charge. If you have other products and services you sell from your website, the free articles will make an excellent "attention grabber" for new customers. In marketing, let everyone know about the free articles available for download. People will visit your website to get their free article and be introduced to your products or services at the same time.

Distribute in Your Regular Mail

If you correspond with relatives or any group by mail, place a copy of this article in your mailing.

Send the Article by Email

When you first download this article in PDF format, make sure you save it on your computer so you can easily find it later. It would be best to make a new folder called something like "articles" and copy all the articles you download from our website inside this folder. When you are ready to send your email, attach the PDF file (in your "articles" folder) and send it.

Create a Booklet

You can also download all the articles available on our website and format them into an attractive booklet. Most people prefer the 5x8" format (the size of a sheet of typing paper folded in half), but you can present the material in any format you desire to fit your audience. You may want to charge a small fee for each booklet to cover your costs for printing and distribution.

Create a Booklet PDF Download

If you purchased the full version of Adobe Acrobat, you can download all the articles available on our website and combine them into one document. You save this one document and provide it as one PDF download (rather than separate article downloads.)
